## TIME TO STOCK UP ON WINTER SHOERING SUPPLIES

Winter is coming! This is a good time to start thinking about your Winter shoeing supply needs, including: Snow Rim Pads, FootPro Solid Carbide Studs, Drive-In Studs – and all the necessary drill bits needed for application.

### FootPro 5/16" Drive-In Studs and FootPro Solid Carbide Studs

FootPro 5/16" Drive-In Studs feature a tapered shaft for excellent seating and good traction. The pins are 4.5mm. There are 100 pins per pack and include a #17 drill bit.



The FootPro Solid Carbide Studs are available in C11 (P-11 equivalent) and C13 (P-13 equivalent). Both require a 17/64" drill bit. Solid carbide provides excellent wear and traction. There will be an insert in each jar cautioning users to not "bottom out" the studs when installing them, and to use a brass or soft face steel hammer. The studs are packed in small jars.

### FootPro 17/64" Countersink Drill Bit

The FootPro 17/64" Countersink Drill Bit can be used for the FootPro Carbide Studs, FootPro 5/16" Drive-in studs and any other studs on the market that require a 17/64" bit. It's not necessary to countersink holes for drive-in studs, but can be helpful in the installation.

### Kerckhaert Snow Rim Pads

Kerckhaert Snow Rim pads come in both urethane (clear) and rubber (black). The urethane pads are longer-wearing for heavy winter use. Each pair comes in an individually wrapped package.

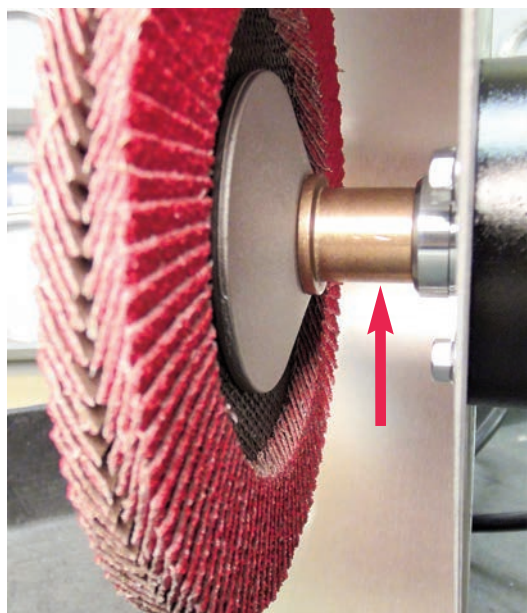
# FOOTPRO DOUBLE SIDED BENCH GRINDER DISC

If you do a lot of heel check grinds this is the attachment for you. It is also useful for notching pads for clips, beveling the inside web of shoes and touch up of clips. It has a 40-grit Ceramic abrasive that does an excellent and efficient job and is long lasting.

A couple quick notes important to mounting the disc properly. It has a 5/8" arbor so it fits perfectly on grinder shafts of 5/8". **However, you need a spacer to keep it far enough from the housing to be able to tighten. That spacer will be 3/4-1" long for most grinders.** Most importantly, it is directional, meaning you can only mount it properly going in one direction. There is an arrow on the label indicating the direction and it should match the direction your grinder shaft is turning. Be sure you check this before using it. If it is mounted in the wrong direction the disc will not work and will be damaged very quickly.



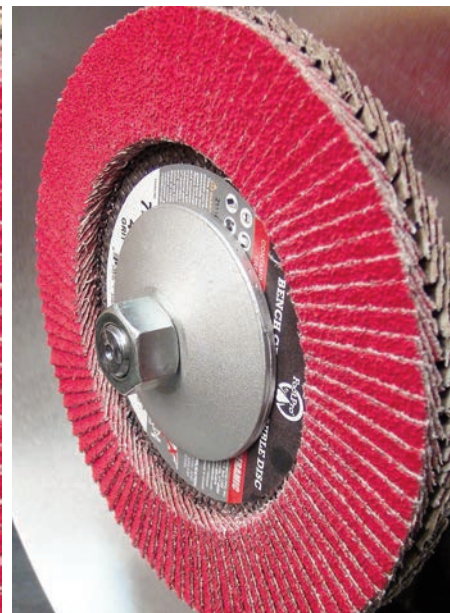
